We enjoyed WOOF Dog Therapy, a visit from a baby chick, watching the Old Settlers Day Parade, and a tasty treat from Culver's.

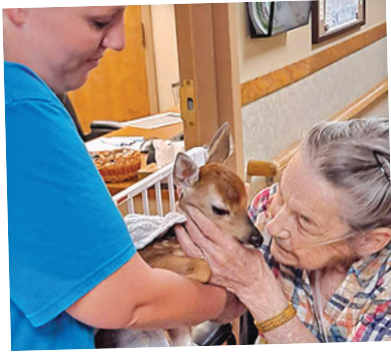

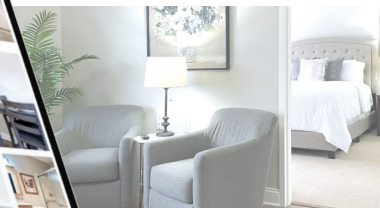

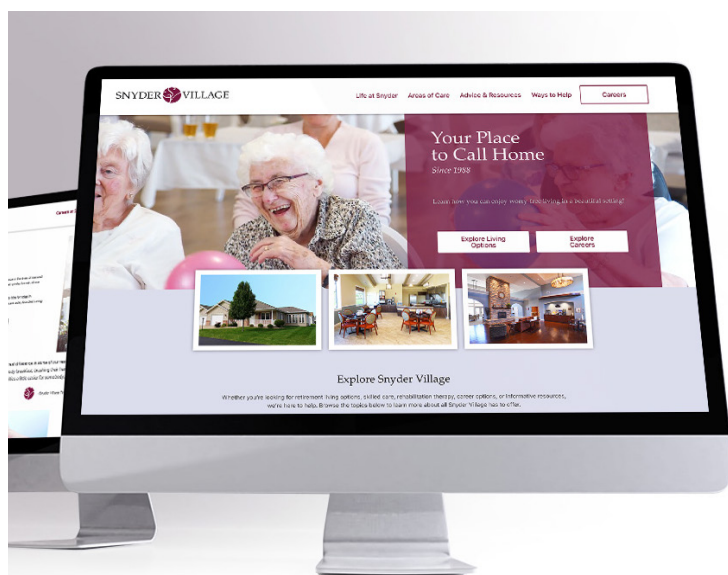
