



VISITATION RULES

Everyone must wear the mask provided during the entire visit – **including the resident** – regardless of vaccination status. *This is updated due to the latest IDPH guidance.*

The mask must cover the nose and mouth at all times.

Visitors must maintain a six-foot distance from other residents and staff.

Visitors must sanitize their hands at the start of the visit.

No food or beverage may be brought to be shared with the resident during the visit.

Visitors are not to leave the resident's room unless they are leaving the building. Please put on the call light for any needs and staff will respond as soon as possible.

Be respectful of the next visitors: Arrive on time and leave on time to allow proper cleaning measures.

Each resident may have up to FOUR visitors per time slot scheduled for outdoor or in-person visits; TWO visitors for in-room visits only to ensure social distancing.

For outdoor or in-person visits, visitors must be older than 5 years of age and must wear a face mask. If you do not have one, one will be provided for you. For in-room visits, visitors must be 16 years old or older.

Violation of these rules will result in you being asked to leave.
