



## HEALTH CENTER VISITATION RULES

Recommended visiting hours are from 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily. Visiting is not encouraged during mealtimes (11:30-12:30 and 4:30-5:30). In the evening, please be considerate of other residents' bedtimes. After hours, visitors should go to the Therapy Entrance, call X191 and screen in at the kiosk.

Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine, should not enter the facility.

All visitors must be screened upon entering and wear name badges throughout entire visit.

Visitors must sanitize their hands at the start of the visit.

After screening, please go directly to your loved one's room.

Visitors must wear the mask provided during the entire visit. The mask must cover the nose and mouth at all times. Visitors must be able to maintain social distancing.

We encourage all visitors to be tested 2-3 days prior to coming to the facility. We encourage visitors to be vaccinated.

**WARNING ABOUT RISK ASSUMED BY VISITORS:** While our staff will attempt to take appropriate precautions consistent with the advice of public health authorities, visitors should understand that they assume the risk of contracting COVID-19 anytime they enter a public space since such precautions do not eliminate the risk of infection.

Snyder Village is unable to provide N-95 masks and encourage visitors who desire to wear one, to bring their own.

Violation of these rules will result in visitors being asked to leave.
