



HEALTH CENTER VISITATION RULES

Visiting hours are from 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily. You must exit the building before 7:30 p.m. Visiting is not encouraged during mealtimes (11:30-12:30 and 4:30-5:30).

All visitors must be screened upon entering and wear name badges throughout entire visit.

Visitors must sanitize their hands at the start of the visit.

Visitors must wear the mask provided during the entire visit. The mask must cover the nose and mouth at all times.

Visitation may take place in the resident's room or in one of the approved visiting locations indicated on the facility map.

- If visiting in a resident's room, the roommate must **NOT** be present. If the roommate is present when you arrive, press the call-light and stand outside of the room to wait for assistance.
- The **resident** may choose to not wear source control when in their room.
- Food or drink may be brought for the resident, but the **visitor's mask must remain in place**. Therefore, visitors should not eat during the visit.
- When visiting in other designated locations, you must ensure social distancing from other residents and staff.

Each resident may have up to FOUR visitors at a time.

Visitors must be 5 years of age or older and must be able to social distance and appropriately wear a mask.

Violation of these rules will result in visitors being asked to leave.
