Visitation Fact Sheet

Outdoor visits are strongly preferable to indoor visits, weather permitting.

All visits will be scheduled in advance with facility staff during business hours.

Call (309) 367-4300 ext. 100 to schedule. We offer several types of visits to accommodate the different needs of the resident and the visitor. Further guidance about the available times and where to arrive will be given once the scheduler knows what type of visit is desired.

A visitor pre-screen will take place via phone within 24 hours of the scheduled visit.

Upon arrival, staff will screen in visitor. This includes taking temperature and observing hand hygiene. At this point, the visitor will be given a mask that must remain on the entirety of the visit.

For in room visits:

- If the resident is fully vaccinated, then the family wears a shield and surgical mask to the room and may remove face shield when in the room but must wear the surgical mask for the entire visit.
- If the resident is **not** fully vaccinated, then the family wears an N95 mask and a face shield for the duration of the in room visit.

Visiting will occur in the activity room in the assigned visiting booth or in a designated area, such as resident's living space.

Items being brought in for residents must fit Snyder Village Guidelines. No food or drink may be brought in to share with the resident during the visit.

No more than two visitors will be allowed at any time, and visitors must be older than 16 years of age, per IDPH guidelines.

Visitors must maintain 6 feet of distance from the residents.

Visits will be supervised, per IDPH guidance.

If a visitor does not follow Snyder Village policy/procedure they may be asked to leave the facility immediately.

Visitors must notify the facility if they test positive for COVID-19 within three days after the visit.

Please be respectful of the next visitors. Arrive on time and leave on time to allow opportunity for proper cleaning measures to take place.
